Florida Parent Network

• Catherine Robinson is the Executive Director of Advocacy and Civic Engagement. She was a former school teacher with 30-year experience working for the Democratic Party, and has lobbied for children before joining Step Up for Children. Being a part of Step Up for Children and the Florida Charter School Alliance, the Florida Parent Network is able to attend school board meetings, attend PTA meetings, rally in support of school choice, conduct workshop, and make phone calls or send emails to the governor in support of school choice. She explained that their advocacy efforts were successful in getting bills in laws, getting lawsuits against school choice dropped, and that advocacy efforts are transferable. This current school year the Florida Parent Network is focusing on support for HB7069 and putting an end to the lawsuit, alternate authorizer for charter school, and charter renewals. Ms. Robinson explained that the Florida Parent Network supports charter schools, voucher programs, and other entities wanting school choice education for children. The Florida Parent Network was part of the agenda and was made a part of these minutes.

CSP Policies and Procedures Manual

- The Board discussed the CSP Policies and Procedures Manual for the CSP Grant process with Faye Wright-Simpson.
- Ms. Wright-Simpson explained that the individual policies within the manual were submitted
 previously to the state, but was asked by the FL DOE to consolidate the policies into one manual.

Per Florida Statute 1012.42, when a teacher is assigned teaching duties out of the field in which the teacher is certified, the parents of all students in the class shall be notified in writing.

Individuals who are teaching out-of-field are certified in at least one area and are qualified to teach, but are required to take additional coursework or testing to add a coverage/endorsement to their certificate. The state also requires a teacher to take coursework/in-service towards an

English to Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) endorsement, when the teacher is the primary language arts provider and/or reading teacher for an ESOL student. The following table lists teachers currently out of field:
