# **State Director Report**

- Dr. Ruiz reviewed the state assessment data overall, by subject area, and in comparison, to local districts and reviewed the areas that need improvement as well as the areas that the school scored higher than the districts. The FCEF BACF portfolio of schools are outperforming their district counterparts in several areas. The board also reviewed the Tier 1, 2, and 3 schools and that the school strategic goals are due on September 30 and will be presented to the board once those plans are finalized.
- Dr. Ruiz also reviewed the COVID data which has been trending downward as well as reviewing the State of Florida Surgeon General Rule 64DER21-15 and implementing this rule.

- The board reviewed the checklist and application from Hillsborough for both Henderson Hammock Charter School and Waterset Charter School.
- The board discussed the Union Park Charter Academy renewal with Pasco county and discussed requesting a 15 year renewal as the school will be a high performing school.
