Pursuant to public notice, the meeting commenced at 9:33 a.m. with a Call to Order by Board Chair Valora Cole. Roll call was taken, and quorum established.

I. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Board Chair Valora Cole asked for public comments. There were none.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE

Approval of the August 11, 2022, Board Meeting Minutes

• The board reviewed the meeting minutes of the August 11, 2022, Florida Charter Educational Foundation, Inc. and Bay Area Charter Foundation, LLC. ("FCEF-BACF") Meeting.

MOTION: Motion was made by Randy Walker and seconded by Steve Knobl to approve the August 11, 2022, Florida Charter Educational Foundation, Inc. and Bay Area Charter Foundation, LLC, Meeting Minutes, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (4-0, 1 absent)

III. CSUSA REPORTS

State Director Update

Dr. Ruiz updated the board on the activities with their portfolio of schools and shared that they
recently had a very successful PLA (Principal Leadership Academy).

School Goals and Initiatives

- Tier 3 Schools Report Dr. Ruiz updated the board on the schools' goals and specific support and initiatives for the Tier 3 schools which are: Clay Charter Academy, Keys Gate Charter School, Winthrop College Prep Academy, and Woodmont Charter School including the ESE focus and focused school support.
- Dr. Ruiz reviewed a comparison of the current assessment and accountability requirement with the new BEST Standards and Florida Accountability Review that are effective for the current year, FY23. The board discussed monitoring and the updated process for testing.

MOTION: Motion was made by Dr. Ramdas Chandra and seconded by Randy Walker to accept the State Director's Report, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (4-0, 1 absent)

- TSIA Report Dr. Ruiz presented to the board the TSIA House Bill 641 ("TSIA") plans submitted and due to new legislation, charter plans will be sent to FLDOE directly without waiting for district plans to be prepared. The Board reviewed the plans.
 - Board Chair Valora Cole shared with the board how glad she is that this process is moving in the right direction and thanked all for getting it done.

MOTION: Motion was made by Dr. Ramdas Chandra and seconded by Randy Walker to approve and ratify the TSIA Allocation plans for the FCEF BACF portfolio of schools for submission, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (4-0, 1 absent)

IV. FINANCIALS

Q4 FY22 Financial Review

- The board reviewed the unaudited Q4 FY22 Finances for Florida Charter Educational Foundation, Inc. and Bay Area Charter Foundation, LLC.
 - Board Director Randy Walker met with Lisanne Morton to review prior to meeting and had requested enrollment reports by grade level for each school.
 - Board Director Steve Knobl inquired whether short falls were due to capacity issues and how the wait lists were organized. Deputy Director Sara Capwell reviewed the enrollment process and how certain grades could be full, but the overall count would be below target and the initiatives in place to ensure the schools met enrollment targets.

MOTION: Motion was made by Dr. Steve Knobl and seconded by Randy Walker to accept the Q4 FY22 Unaudited Financial Review for Florida Charter Educational Foundation, Inc. and Bay Area Charter Foundation, LLC, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (4-0, 1 absent)

V. OLD BUSINESS

Grants Process Manual

The board reviewed the Grants Process Manual.

MOTION: Motion was made by Dr. Ramdas Chandra and seconded by Randy Walker to approve the Grants Process Manual for the Florida Charter Educational Foundation, Inc. and Bay Area Charter Foundation, LLC., portfolio of schools, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (4-0, 1 absent)

Innovation Preparatory Academy 3 Charter Contract

The board reviewed the executed Innovation Preparatory Academy 3 Charter Contract.

MOTION: Motion was made by Dr. Steve Knobl and seconded by Dr. Ramdas Chandra to accept the Innovation Preparatory Academy 3 Charter Contract with Pasco County School Board and the Florida Charter Educational Foundation, Inc., as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (4-0, 1 absent)

Charter Renewals

- Creekside Charter Academy Board Attorney Levi Williams updated the board on the renewal application for Creekside Charter Academy containing two surveys that have not been in previous applications regarding the board contracting with an education services provider and a financial health survey that has questions that implies wrongdoing. While it is outside of the purview of the district, his legal counsel, is to complete the information under protest.
- Board Director Randy Walker inquired if this procedure is legal. Mr. Williams advised that this
 is outside of the scope of statute.
- Board Director Dr. Ramdas Chandra refrained from further comments due to the nature of the issue.

MOTION: Motion was made by Randy Walker and seconded by Dr. Steve Knobl to the best of the Board's ability, the Board objects to the Sponsor's inclusion of its new Education Service Providers Survey and School Finance Management Survey as a mandatory disclosure requirement, without cause, for the charter renewal of Creekside, as the completion of the two surveys are mandatory, be it known that the Board authorizes the Chair to use all necessary professional resources to complete the surveys and to make it known to the Sponsor that these sections of the renewal are being submitted under protest. Motion was approved unanimously. (4-0, 1 absent)

Board Director Dr. Steve Knobl commended Principal Lane Morris for his outstanding work with the school and assured that this issue has no connection to his leadership and thanked all for great work at the school.

Rita Weaver updated the board on the Sarasota application and appeal and advised that the September 8, 2022, FLDOE meeting had been cancelled and that this will be rescheduled, and the board will be notified as negotiations continue.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

CSUSA Student Progression Plan

 The board reviewed the CSUSA Student Progression Plan for schools in three of the districts in the board's portfolio of schools.
