State Director Update

- Dr. Ruiz provided an update on the first few weeks of school. Currently schools are completing IPass and Quest visits with FAST PM1 Data almost finalized.
- Dr. Ruiz provided and update on school goals' and he reminded the board that grades will be posted in December. He noted that all schools in the portfolio improved or remained the same except for one school. This year's goals are based on proficiency only. The FCEF BACF portfolio of schools improved with the exception of Woodmont Charter School.
- LaShonda White, Area 1 Deputy Director, stated she would be focused on "Teaching and Learning" goals this year for her LKeys Gate Charter School.
- Dr. Sara Capwell, Area 3 Deputy Director, stated that Woodmont would be focusing on increasing teacher capacity and coaching. State and National Team support will be provided as well as daily support to provide a student-centered environment.
- Dr. Capwell proved an update on College Preparatory Academy at Wellen Park noting that
 the school has a collegiate focus, with all areas of the school are aligning with a colligate
 focus including a partnership with the State College located near the school.
- Dr. Knobl thanked to principals and deputies for the success on increasing the school grades.
